I, _____, will uphold the following requirements to participate on the Mannheim American High School (MAHS) Varsity or Junior Varsity Football Teams.

1. Attendance

- Be on time to all scheduled practices and games.
- One absence in a week will result in sitting out half of the upcoming game.
- Two absences will result in not being allowed to travel to an away game unless extenuating circumstances exist. This is at the discretion of the head coach.
- Chronic tardiness or absences will result in parent meeting and then removal from the team.
- No other team member may explain your absence; this is your responsibility.

2. Physicals, Medical and Conduct Forms

- Have a current physical exam on file. Physical forms are available from the school nurse. Notify the coach of any medication requirements.
- Complete force protection, medical power of attorney, DoDDs and MAHS Code of Conducts and medical release forms.

3. Uniform Expectations

- Players are responsible for issued uniform and gear and will pay for any damages or losses.
- Uniforms and gear will be returned following the last game of the season or upon removal.
- Not turning in issued gear makes you ineligible to receive post-season recognition.
- Issued uniforms are for games only and not to be worn during practice or in the community.

4. School Policies

- Players will not use or possess tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal drugs. If caught player may be subject to suspension or removal from the team.
- Players will not skip classes even if preparing for away games. I will be in school at least 3 full consecutive periods game day or the day before a game if it is not on a required school day.
- Players will meet the grade eligibility requirements of MAHS. Failure to do so can result in suspension or removal from team.
- Players will behave in an appropriate manner on the bus and public facilities en route to away games.

5. Team Conduct

- I will show respect for all team members, coaches, and officials.
- I will help my teammates and encourage rather than criticize.
- I will not attack (verbally or physically) another school's team member or coach.
- I will not attack (verbally or physically) an official or referee.
- I will exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.

6. Concerns

If a player or parent has a concern regarding the conduct of a coach, paid or volunteer, first report it to the head coach. If it cannot be dealt with adequately with him, then both head coach and parent will arrange a meeting with MAHS Administrator.
